

A FENCE PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FENCE, WHETHER IT IS A NEW FENCE OR FOR THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF AN EXISTING FENCE.

Fence Permit Checklist

1. Owners/Applicants should obtain approval from all utilities, including drainage and sewer services before building a fence.
2. Owners/Applicants must sketch a plan to present to the Town of Lockport. (It does not have to be to scale.)
3. Owners/Applicants must apply for and receive a permit.
4. Owners/Applicants must clearly mark where the fence will be built on the property and notify the Town for inspection.
5. Owners/Applicants must call Louisiana One Call at 1-800-272-3020 before digging.
6. Owners/Applicants must abide by the following ordinances in constructing the fence:

Code of Ordinances, Town of Lockport, Louisiana Sec. 48-90. - Regulations for fences.
7. Owners/Applicants must notify the Town of Lockport for final inspection.

Fences Built on Servitudes

Fences are allowed to be built within some servitudes, but conditions do apply. Fences constructed within or crossing servitudes are built at the owner's risk. The owner is responsible for moving the fence if the Town or a utility wants access to use the servitude. Once notified, if the owner does not move the fence, the fence can be torn down or moved at the owner's expense.
